For the sake of clarity, the meeting minutes are organized in numeric order to reflect original order on the agenda; however, issues were taken out of order during the meeting.

1. Call to Order and Roll Call

The Physical Therapy Board of California (Board) teleconference was called to order at 2:07 p.m. Roll was taken and the following members were present: Dr. Sara Takii, Physical Therapist, Dr. Debra J. Alviso, Physical Therapist, Ms. Marty Jewell, PT, Ph.D., Mr. Donald A. Chu, PT, Ph.D., and Mr. James E. Turner. Ms. Karen B. Pines was absent. A quorum was established.

2. Discussion/Action – Proposed Amendment to Title 16, Division 13.2, Section 1398.44 of the California Code of Regulations: Adequate Supervision Defined

Mr. Steven K. Hartzell informed the Board that public comments were not received regarding the amendment made to CCR Section 1398.44 (d)(8) at the March 1, 2011 teleconference; therefore, staff will proceed with the rulemaking file.

3. Actions by the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy (FSBPT) to Test NPTE Candidates on Fixed Dates3

Mr. Jason Kaiser explained the FSBPT has lifted the restriction to test for all physical therapist applicants; however, the FSBPT has also implemented fixed testing dates to all physical therapist applicants, foreign and domestic, commencing July 1, 2010. The fixed testing dates will not apply to physical therapist assistant applicants; they may continue to test on a continuous basis. As of the last FSBPT Webinar, the proposed testing dates

48 for the remainder of 2010 are: September 7th, October 7th, and December 5th. The
49 FSBPT reported there will be five testing dates in 2012 approximately 10 weeks apart.

50
51 Mr. Hartzell added the FSBPT will be increasing the exam fee from \$370 to \$400 in 2013
52 for all candidates.

53
54 Mr. Hartzell shared the California Physical Therapy Association (CPTA) has a
55 placeholder bill for the current legislative session. There is a possibility of using the
56 placeholder bill to add license applicant status as it will apply to the fixed testing test
57 imposed by the FSBPT to the Board's statutory authority.

60 **bring the Board in compliance with fixed testing dates.**

69 Mr. Hartzell reported Dr. Norman Hertz is working with the FSBPT today, reviewing
70 evidence to determine whether the NPTE exam is secure and if the actions taken by the
71 FSBPT were justified.
