- ①June 3: Last day for bills to be passed out of the house of origin
- ②June 6: Last day for policy committees to meet and report bills
- August 15: Legislature reconvenes from Summer Recess
- ③August 26: Last day for fiscal committees to meet and report bills to the Floor
- ④September 2: Last day to amend bills on the Floor
- September 9: Last day for each house to pass bills
