The legislation has a significant positive effect on the regulation of the practice of physical therapy and will benefit the consumer. The Board may provide written or verbal testimony in support of the bill as appropriate.

Support if Amended

The legislation could have a significant positive effect on the regulation of the practice of physical therapy and will benefit the consumer if the legislation is amended to include a specific amendment that the Board is proposing. The Board may provide written or verbal testimony requesting that the bill be amended. If the bill is amended to include the recommendation and there are no other amendments that will negatively affect the bill, the position will change to support.

Watch

The legislation does not currently have an identified impact on the regulation of the practice of physical therapy. However, the possibility exists that future amendments may affect the regulation of physical therapy and the consumer.

Disapprove- Unless Amended

The legislation has a negative effect on the practice of physical therapy that will negatively impact the regulation of the practice physical therapy and the consumer. However, if the legislation is amended to include a specific amendment that the Board is proposing, the effect on the regulation of the practice of physical therapy and the consumer may change to insignificant or even beneficial. The Board may provide written testimony requesting amendment of the bill. If the bill is amended to include the recommendation and there are not other amendments that will negatively affect the bill, the position will change to watch.

Disapprove

The legislation has a negative effect on the practice of physical therapy that will negatively impact the regulation of the practice physical therapy and the consumer. The Board may provide written testimony in opposition of the bill as appropriate.

Oppose – Unless Amended
